Join the celebration of 19th century living in rural Florida at an educational festival of local history, and FUN!

Why come to Farm and Forest?

- Concern for historical accuracy has guided the selection of activities, demonstrators, vendors and entertainers.
- Trained interpretive guides will create an educational and entertaining atmosphere.
- Students experience the cultural history of Florida's 19th century rural life by visiting our Living History farm, including an 1840's cabin, 100 year-old kitchen, twin-crib barn and forge.
- Students discover skills such as rope-making, blacksmithing, spinning, weaving, basketry, and other traditional skills practiced by early Florida pioneers through demonstrations.
- Your group will love participating in a variety of traditional games like tin can stilts, the bean bag toss, tug-o-war and relay races!
- Live heritage music will be played throughout the festival!
- Historical and environmental groups with educational displays and games will be onsite.
- Admission for School Days is half price when you pre-register —only \$1.50 for children and \$2.50 for adults. Bus drivers in uniform are admitted free.
- Horse-drawn wagon rides are offered at reduced cost.
- Children participating in School Days receive a free pass to attend the festival again on Saturday or Sunday when accompanied by a paying adult.
- Food will be available for sale, including a special low-cost kids' menu on School Days.
