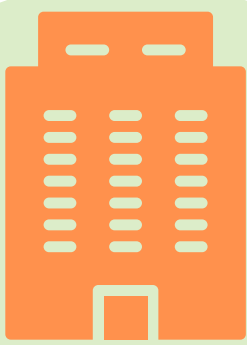
For Land Uses Other Than Single-Family

WHAT IS THE DIAMETER OF THE TREE?

Tree removal permits are required for trees 8" in diameter, except Slash and Loblolly Pine require permits when they are 20" in diameter. **Be sure to measure the diameter of the tree at 4 1/2 feet from the ground!**

Examples include:

- Common areas
- Townhouses
- Trees that were planted to meet mitigation requirements when the subdivision was constructed



All trees planted in parking lots, adjacent to the street, or in areas which might be part of the approved landscape plan require permits, **even if they are smaller than 8"**.
