<b>Description</b>	<p>Built in the late 1800's, the Union Academy was the intellectual heart of the African American community for almost 60 years. It was the second largest school building built by the Bureau of Freedmen Refugees and Abandoned Lands in the state of Florida. In 1941 the building was redone and the solid concrete structure remains active today, named in honor of Rosa B. Williams and used as a recreation center for the community.</p>
